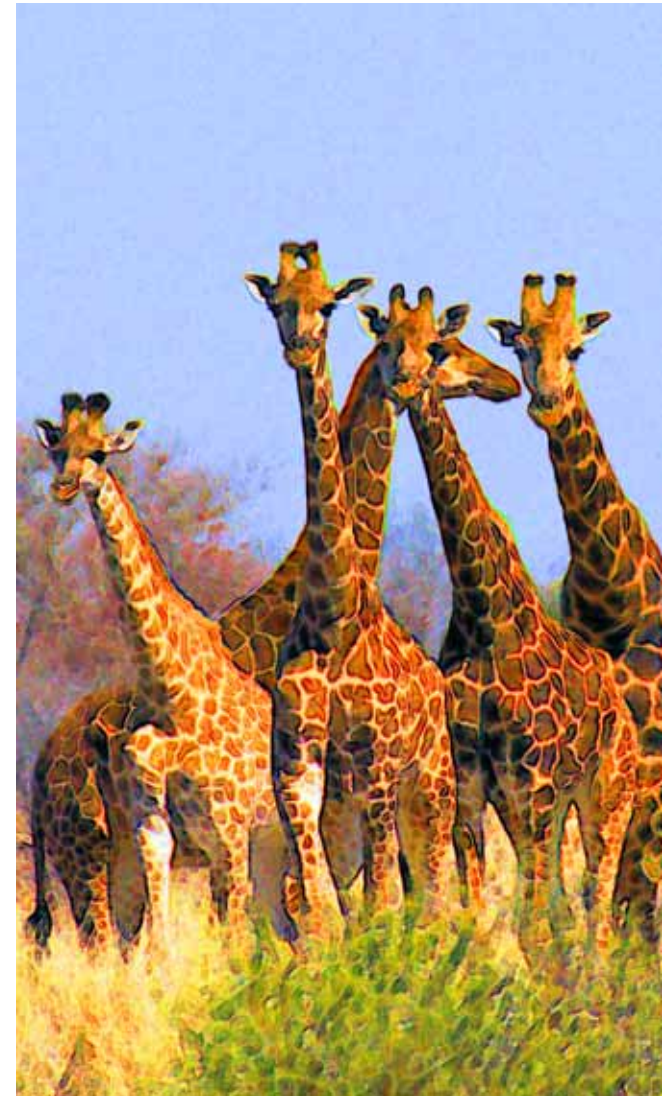

DIVERSITY is what makes our living Earth such a wondrous place. The images in this collection reflect that wonder in a manner that inspires the imagination to dream.

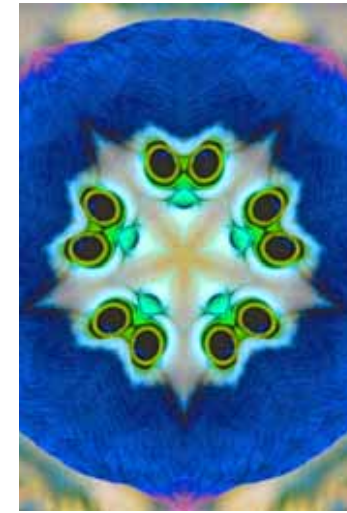


And when we dream, **CREATIVITY** abounds. Turning traditional photography into art, nature re-shapes itself, forming a kaleidoscope of colour and shape.
